AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CONNELLSVILLE, FAYETTE COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, REPEALING AND REPLACING SECTION 3 (f) (Replacement of Pavement and
Surfacing) OF ORDINANCE NO. 2018-3, ALSO KNOWN AS
THE STREET CUTTING AND DIGGING ORDINANCE

IT IS HEREBY ordained and enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Connellsville Township, Fayette County, as follows:

SECTION I. REPEALER

This Ordinance hereby repeals Section 3 (f), Replacement of Pavement and Surfacing), of Ordinance No. 2018-3, also known as the Street Cutting and Digging Ordinance.

SECTION II. WILL READ AS FOLLOWS:

A. Any person, firm, utility or corporation that trenches and/or excavates over 5 feet on any Township streets or alleys will be required to pave said street or alley curb to curb or, in the absence of curbs, the entire width of the paved surface. This includes but is not limited to sewer lines, water lines, gas lines, telephone lines, cable lines and fiber optic lines.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval as required by law.
